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How should I start putting my grant together?



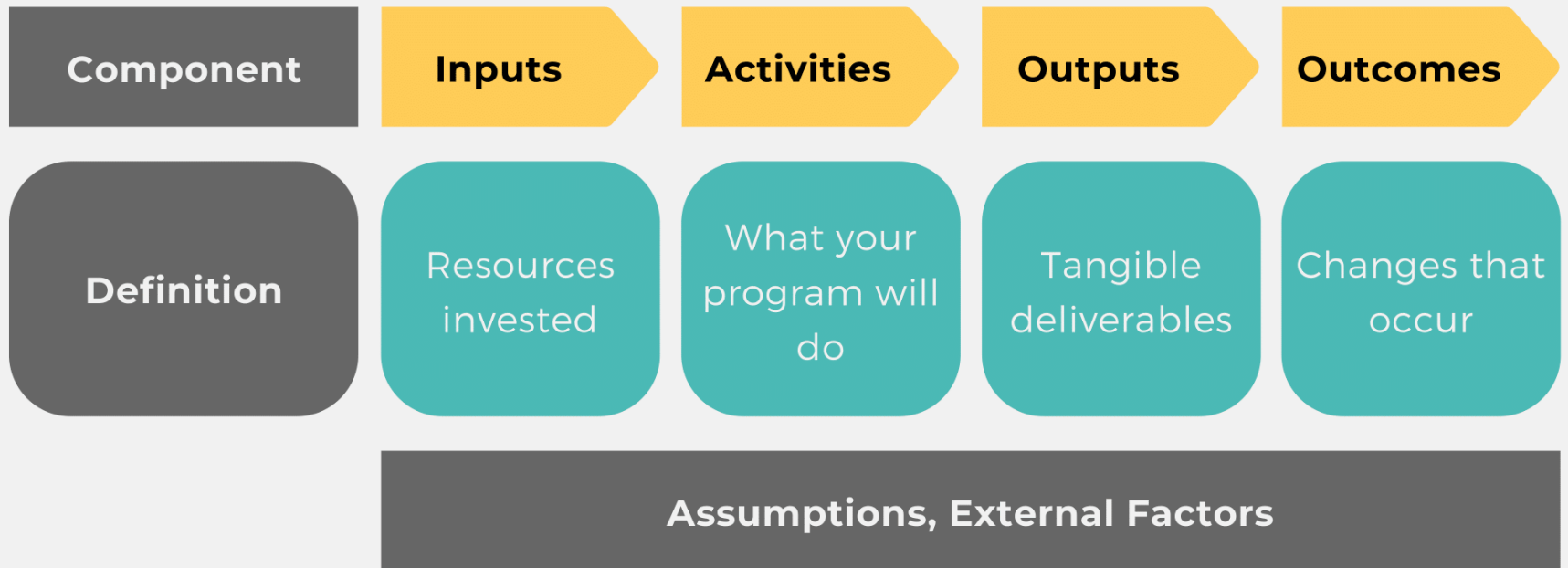
Look at...

- existing planning documents or needs assessments
- funding considerations
- desired end of year goals

Perhaps a logic model would help!




Logic Model Structure





Inputs



What do you need to carry out the activities at the frequency and scale needed to achieve the outputs?

Include in-kind services, contributions





Activities



What major things will you do or complete to achieve your indicators?

Examples:

Collect, distribute ___ pounds of food over six months

SPECIFIC

You should know the outcome of your goal

M

MEASURABLE

You should know when you will have reached your goal

A

ACHIEVABLE

You should be able to achieve your goals

R

RELEVANT

Will your goal help you in the long run?

T

TIME-BOUND

Set a time frame for your goals




Outputs

What quantifiable results will your activities achieve in order to meet your indicators?

Usually begins with a number and correlates with a specific activity.




Outcomes



What are the measurable outcomes for the public and your program participants based on your program's activities?

Example: We will ensure 50% of the target population will be better informed about ___ by the sixth month

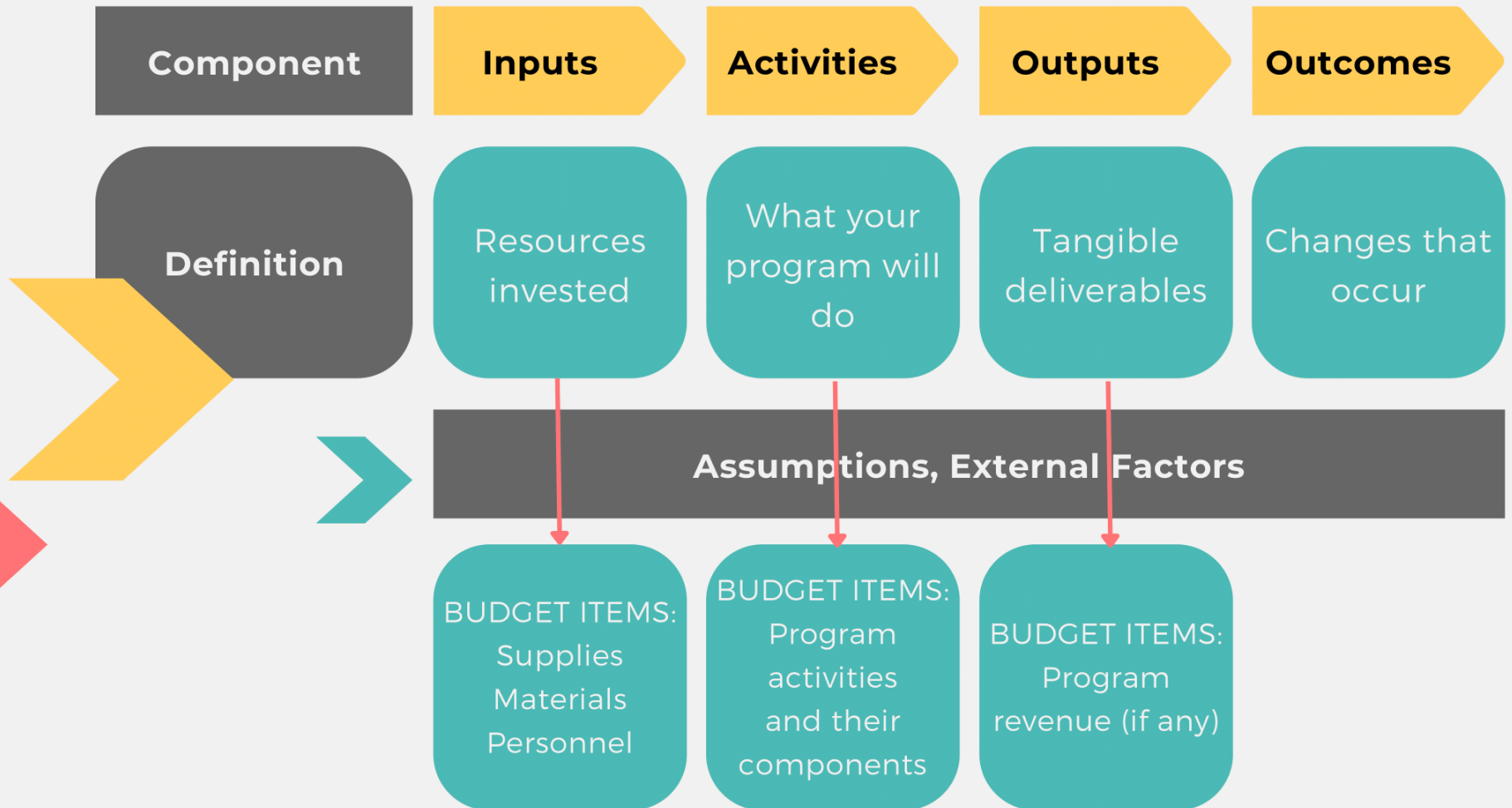
